2024-25 Ozaukee Youth Apprenticeship Scholarship Instructions

Each year, Ozaukee Youth Apprenticeships (OYA) awards scholarships to selected Youth Apprenticeship students for their post-secondary education. Students must complete their Youth Apprenticeship to receive an OYA Scholarship awarded.

Applicants are chosen based on:

- Scholarship Application completion and of all documents to the OYA office which must include:
 - One Employer Recommendation
 - One Educator Recommendation
 - A Career Essay (Typewritten - No more than 250 words)
 - Include the benefits you have received from participating in your apprenticeship, how you feel you contributed to the industry in which you worked, and how you think this experience will carry over into your future education and career plans.
 - An up-to-date High School Transcript
